
## What does heaven look like?

Revelation chapters 21-22

Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer any sea. And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them, and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away." Revelation 21:1-4

And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the holy city, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, having the glory of God. Her brilliance was like a very costly stone, as a stone of crystal-clear jasper. It had a great and high wall, with twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels; and names were written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel. There were three gates on the east and three gates on the north and three gates on the south and three gates on the west. And the wall of the city had twelve foundation stones, and on them were the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. The one who spoke with me had a gold measuring rod to measure the city, and its gates and its wall. The city is laid out as a square, and its length is as great as the width; and he measured the city with the rod, fifteen hundred miles; its length and width and height are equal. Revelation 21:10-16



And he measured its wall, seventy-two yards, according to human measurements, which are also angelic measurements. The material of the wall was jasper; and the city was pure gold, like clear glass. The foundation stones of the city wall were adorned with every kind of precious stone. The first foundation stone was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, chalcedony; the fourth, emerald; the fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, topaz; the tenth, chrysoprase; the eleventh, jacinth; the twelfth, amethyst. And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; each one of the gates was a single pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass. I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. And the city has no need of the sun or of the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp is the Lamb. Revelation 21:17-23



### New Testament age believers in the Savior Jesus

- After death, believers immediately go to <u>Paradise</u>
- παράδεισος [paradeisos] had the original meaning of "garden" or "hunting ground"
- And he was saying, "Jesus, remember me when You come in Your kingdom!"
   And He said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in
   <u>Paradise</u>." Luke 23:42-43
- "I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago—whether in the body I do not know, or out of the body I do not know, God knows—such a man was caught up to the third heaven. And I know how such a man—whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, God knows— was caught up into <u>Paradise</u> and heard inexpressible words, which a man is not permitted to speak." 2 Corinthians 12:2-4



## The Judgment Seat of Christ does not determine one's salvation

"For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them." Ephesians 2:8-10

"Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve. For he who does wrong will receive the consequences of the wrong which he has done, and that without partiality." Colossians 3:23-25

## The Judgment Seat of Christ does evaluate a person's earthly deeds

"For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work. If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward. If any man's work is burned up, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire." 1 Corinthians 3:11-15

Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord [we will all stand before a holy God someday], we persuade men, but we are made manifest to God; and I hope that we are made manifest also in your consciences. We are not again commending ourselves to you but are giving you an occasion to be proud of us, so that you will have an answer for those who take pride in appearance and not in heart. For if we are beside ourselves, it is for God; if we are of sound mind, it is for you. 2 Corinthians 5:11-13

Is this true in our lives?

What really controls us?

It should be the <u>love</u> of Christ.

Not the guilt of Christ

Not the professional advancement of Christ

Not the selfish desires of Christ

For the love of Christ controls us, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died; and He died for all [not just the "elect"], so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf. Therefore from now on we recognize no one according to the flesh; even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him in this way no longer. 2 Corinthians 5:14-16

## What happens when we meet the Savior?

Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a <u>new</u> creature [Jesus said "born again" to Nicodemus in John 3:3]; the old things passed away; behold, <u>new</u> things have come. 2 Corinthians 5:17

- "New" is Greek adjective καινός *kainos* 
  - **Definitions:** that which has come into being and was not previously present, new as to form or quality, of different nature, new in quality not just in sequence
  - Paul did NOT use Greek adjective νέος neos which means "recent, updated, young"
  - Kainos is new in kind and in contrast to what previously existed, so taking the place
    thereof. In that sense kainos looks backward, while its synonym neos looks
    forward. Kainos is equivalent to "not yet having been"; neos is "not having long been"

## What does a disunited, conflicted society need?

Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:18-19

καταλλάσσω katallasso "return to favor with, be reconciled"

## Reconciliation

- 1. Jesus earned our reconciliation with the Father by His death on the cross
- 2. We are offered reconciliation with God by faith in Jesus the Savior
- 3. After we receive reconciliation from God, we offer forgiveness (emotion) and seek reconciliation (action)
- 4. Reconciliation follows repentance
- 5. Reconciliation is part of God's eternal plan

\*The future of the Jewish race depended on Joseph and his brothers being reconciled ("preserve" in Genesis 45:7)

\*Our future in heaven is dependent on us being reconciled to God by faith

## When a nation needs to be reconciled to God, the Heavenly Father chooses people for a mission

Therefore, we are <u>ambassadors for Christ</u>, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be <u>reconciled</u> to God. 2 Corinthians 5:20

## **What is an ambassador?** πρεσβεύω *presbeuo*

An ambassador is the President's highest-ranking representative to a specific nation or international organization abroad. An effective ambassador has to be a strong leader—a good manager, a resilient negotiator, and a respected representative of the United States. https://diplomacy.state.gov/diplomacy/what-are-the-roles-of-a-diplomat/

An ambassador is an official envoy, especially a high-ranking diplomat who represents a state and is usually accredited to another sovereign state or to an international organization as the resident representative of their own government or sovereign <u>or</u> appointed for a special and often temporary diplomatic assignment.

- How are you representing?
  - As if He Himself were speaking

- You speak on behalf of the boss
