



Jesus said, "For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and in various places there will be famines and earthquakes." Matthew 24:7



- •The Greek term ὧδῖνες *odines* refer to the birth pangs a woman experiences while in labor.
- •In Hebrew, this is referred to by the phrase "chevlei Moshiach" חבלי דמשיח, literally "the birth pangs of the Messiah."



How Many People Have Smartphones In The World?

According to Statista, the **current number of smartphone users in the world today is 6.378 billion**, and this means **80.76% of the world's population owns a smartphone**. This figure is up considerably from 2016 when there were only 3.668 billion users, 49.40% of that year's global population.

In 2021, including both smart and feature phones, **the current number of mobile phone users is 7.10 billion**, which makes **89.90% of people in the world cell phone owners**. Feature phones are the basic cell phones without apps and complex OS systems, more prominent in developing countries.


When the Antichrist appears



"But immediately after the tribulation [θλῖψις thlipsis] of those days the SUN WILL BE DARKENED, AND THE MOON WILL NOT GIVE ITS LIGHT, AND THE STARS WILL FALL from the sky, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken." Matthew 24:29

"There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth dismay among nations, in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves, men fainting from fear and the expectation of the things which are coming upon the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken." Luke 21:25–26

Truly I say to you, this generation [or "people", the Jews] will not pass away until all these things take place." Matthew 24:32-24

γενεά genea... Greek noun translated as "generation", "time", "age", and "nation"

Thus says the Lord, Who gives the sun for light by day and the fixed order of the moon and the stars for light by night, Who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar; the Lord of hosts is His name: "If this fixed order departs from before Me," declares the Lord, "then the offspring of Israel also will cease from being a nation before Me forever." Thus says the Lord, "If the heavens above can be measured and the foundations of the earth searched out below, then I will also cast off all the offspring of Israel for all that they have done," declares the Lord. Jeremiah 31:35-37

Thus after proclaiming the New Covenant at Jeremiah 31:31–34, God immediately states that the Jewish people will last at least as long as the sun and the moon. Both Yeshua and Jeremiah refute Replacement theology.

"For the vision is yet for the appointed time; it hastens toward the goal and it will not fail. Though it tarries, wait for it; for it will certainly come, it will not delay." Habakkuk 2:3

So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?" What does the Second Coming of Jesus look like?

In that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, which is in front of Jerusalem on the east; and the Mount of Olives will be split in its middle from east to west by a very large valley, so that half of the mountain will move toward the north and the other half toward the south. Zechariah 14:4

- These are the records of the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his time; Noah walked with God. Genesis 6:9
- Noah is called a "preacher of righteousness" in 2 Peter 2:5. What is <u>our</u> calling in these days?

- God said to Noah, "Make for yourself an ark of gopher wood; you shall make the ark with rooms, and shall cover it inside and out with pitch." Genesis 6:14





What does it feel like to live in today's world?

Are we living in the "days of Noah"?

Jesus said, "Then there will be two men in the field; one will be taken and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken and one will be left." Matthew 24:40-41
