# How many Bible prophecies are there?

- J. Barton Payne's Encyclopedia of Biblical Prophecy lists
- 1,239 prophecies in the Old Testament
- 578 prophecies in the New Testament
- A total of 1,817 Bible prophecies
- These prophecies encompass 8,352 verses
- At the time the Bible was written, 27% of the Bible was prophetic

# Who else believes Bible prophecy is true?

"Remember the former things long past, for lam God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things which have not been done, saying, 'My purpose will be established, and I will accomplish all My good pleasure'" Isaiah 46:9-10

- Notice the variety of topics and situations mentioned.
- Think about how strange or obscure these prophecies might have sounded to the original writers and original readers.
- Did the prophets themselves wonder whether or not God would keep His promises?
- Look at these ancient promises in two ways...
  - Things we read about in the Bible and wonder if God could actually do that.
  - Things we see around us and then learn that they are happening because God's Word declared they would.

#### Isaiah 41:12-14

#### Massacre Averted – God protects His people


During summer 2015, it was discovered that Hamas had been using supplies given by Israel for civil projects to build tunnels that would enable them to transport weapons and invade Israel. In the weeks before July 17, Hamas terrorists scouted out the area which one of their tunnels would potentially end, near the farming village of Sufa. It was perfect. At the time, this was a populated area of farmers concealed by tall wheat. Israel wouldn't stand a chance. However, the terrorists didn't count on the apparent power of faith. According to Jewish customs, there is a biblical mandate that requires farmers to harvest before taking a sabbatical year, in which it is forbidden to harvest in Israel. On July 17, terrorists exited their completed tunnel only to find an empty open land. This attempted attack happened to occur just after the sabbatical year had begun and so, the religious farmers were no longer harvesting. Without the tall wheat for cover, the terrorists were quickly spotted and intercepted by the Israeli Defense Forces. A potential massacre was avoided because of this miracle.





#### The Reforestation of Israel

Of Israel's many accomplishments, one of the most impressive may be the reforestation of the land. From the turn of the twentieth century a huge amount of work has gone into planting trees and turning the land green.




Since 1900 roughly 250,000,000 trees have been planted across Israel and it is the only county in the world that ended the 20th century with more trees than it had in 1900. In 1948 roughly 2% of Israel was covered in trees and this has now grown to around 8.5%.

Israel's forests do more than just provide a nice place to hike; they bring with them a huge amount of benefit in areas such as fruit production, grazing and habitat for a range of wildlife, carbon absorption and more. Furthermore, they are a testament to Israel's commitment to combating droughts, an area of research that is always developing.

- From the east: Many Jews living in the Middle East moved to Israel by the early 1900s.
- From the west: During mid-1900s, hundreds of thousands of Jews living in Europe and the US began moving to Israel.
- From the north: The Soviet Union refused to allow its Jewish residents to move to Israel. After years of pressure from other countries, Russia began to allow Jews to return to Israel in the 1980s. More than 1 Million Russian Jews have moved to Israel.
- From the south: In 1985, Israel struck a deal with Ethiopia's communist government to allow the Jews of Ethiopia to move to Israel. In May, 1991, 14,500 Ethiopian Jews were airlifted to Israel.

# The US Embassy Opening in Jerusalem





In December 2017, the United Nations voted 128-9 against President Donald Trump's recognition of Jerusalem as the capital of Israel and the home of the future American embassy. Rabbi Shimon Apisdorf saw the UN vote, which sought to isolate Jerusalem from the world, as proof that the Third Temple will rise again. While the vote was an attempt by Israel's enemies to "put Jerusalem under siege" and "isolate the city," similar to what occurred with the destruction of Solomon's Temple and the Babylonian Exile, Rabbi Apisdorf said, "The seeds of Messiah were hidden, planted in the destruction of the Temple. This seems like a blow to Israel, but what is really happening is that the world is focused on the relationship of the Jewish people to Jerusalem, and only good things can come out of that."

#### On board the new Jerusalem-Tel Aviv fast train

It's been a long time coming, but Israeli commuters are finally able to board doubledecker high-speed trains on a new link from Jerusalem to Tel Aviv.

Construction has been plagued by engineering and planning challenges, and the last section of the line is still not open. The route has also angered some Palestinians, as part of the track runs in tunnels under the occupied West Bank.

Transport Minister Yisrael Katz hopes it will eventually whisk passengers from secular, liberal Tel Aviv to a "Donald Trump Station" next to the Western Wall, one of Judaism's holiest sites.
