"Then there will be a fourth kingdom as strong as iron; inasmuch as iron crushes and shatters all things, so, like iron that breaks in pieces, it will crush and break all these in pieces. 





Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent word to assemble the satraps, the prefects and the governors, the counselors, the treasurers, the judges, the magistrates and all the rulers of the provinces to come to the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up. Then the satraps, the prefects and the governors, the counselors, the treasurers, the judges, the magistrates and all the rulers of the provinces were assembled for the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up. **Daniel 3:2-3**


Why did this king build this type of statue?


Nebuchadnezzar knew his dream and Daniel's interpretation, that God would keep His covenant with the Jews and defeat these Gentile empires. The Babylonian king did not want that to happen, he wanted God to break His covenant with the Jews. How could he make that happen? If he tempted the most faithful and righteous Jews to abandon God and sin by bowing down to worship a false idol.

If the later kingdoms are never formed, the only empire that would remain in power would be the that of the "gold head" which is Babylon.


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Where was Daniel?

- Scripture does not say where Daniel was when King Nebuchadnezzar tried to kill his friends.
- Maybe Daniel was traveling and located elsewhere.
- Maybe he did not have to be there because not everyone was there. Only the representatives from the various regions of the empire had to be there; Daniel was higher ranking than that (Daniel 2:48).
- Maybe Daniel was not required to bow down to the golden image because in the eyes of Nebuchadnezzar HE WAS A GOD (Daniel 2:46).



Unconditional Obedience

Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego replied to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we do not need [we are not hesitant] to give you an answer concerning this matter. If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the furnace of blazing fire; and He will deliver us out of your hand, O king." Daniel 3:16-17






"But even if He does not, let it be known to you, O king, that we are not going to serve your gods or worship the golden image that you have set up."

*Will you still trust God even if He does not pull you out of the fire?


Why not bow down?

"You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth. You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments." Exodus 20:4-6



*If Nebuchadnezzar wanted to torture the men, he would have made it LESS hot, not MORE hot, so the death would take longer.


*Maybe the king respected the God of the Jews but thought He would not be powerful enough to protect them from such intense heat.



*Wearing all their clothing... the Gemara taught that even in mortal danger, a person should not change his normal style in the face of the oppressors. This shows he is not subordinate spiritually, even if weaker physically.

Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astounded and stood up in haste; he said to his high officials, "Was it not three men we cast bound into the midst of the fire?" They replied to the king, "Certainly, O king." He said, "Look! I see four men loosed and walking about in the midst of the fire without harm, and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of the gods [bar elahin לְבַר־אֵלְהִין!" Daniel 3:24-25

"Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel." Isaiah 7:14



Then Nebuchadnezzar came near [drew closer] to the door of the furnace of blazing fire; he responded [shouted] and said, "Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego, come out, you servants of the Most High God, and come here!" Then Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego came out of the midst of the fire. The satraps, the prefects, the governors and the king's high officials gathered around and saw in regard to these men that the fire had no effect on the bodies of these men nor was the hair of their head singed, nor were their trousers damaged, nor had the smell of fire even come upon them. Daniel 3:26-27

*"Although they were confident of the miracle that had been performed for them, they did not dare to treat the king lightly, to go out without permission." – Rashi

*Where were the rest of the officials? Maybe they were those who put the men in originally.


Is God able to protect me?

"But now, thus says the Lord, your Creator, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel, "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine! When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they will not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, nor will the flame burn you."

Obedience Observed

Nebuchadnezzar said, "Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who has sent His angel and delivered His servants who put their trust in Him, violating the king's command, and yielded up [risked] their bodies so as not to serve or worship any god except their own God." Daniel 3:28



Lessons from the Fiery Furnace

- Sometimes the opportunity to stand up for righteousness is placed upon and you will have to stand alone (Daniel 3:7)
- Disobedience to God is contagious <u>but</u> so is Obedience to God
- People are watching you as you follow Jesus
- How will you react when your faith is challenged? (Daniel 3:15)
- The cause of the men's suffering was their refusal to worship the false gods of the world
- Are my worship and obedience conditional or unconditional?
- God honors those who honor and obey Him
- The Son of God is present with His followers during the worst and scariest times of life
