Who was Ezekiel?

History Lesson

- When King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon captured Jerusalem in 597 BC, he took many of the leading citizens of Jerusalem as hostages to Babylon, among whom was Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzi (1:3). They were resettled at a place called Tel Abib on the river Chebar, one of the tributary canals of the Euphrates River southeast of Babylon. It was there that Ezekiel received his call as a prophet of the Lord in 593 BC.
- His prophetic call came to him "in the fifth year of Jehoiachin's captivity" (594 BC, see 1:2). He lost his wife in the ninth year of exile, by some sudden and unforeseen stroke (Ezek. 8:1; 24:18). He held a prominent place among the exiles, and was frequently consulted by the elders (8:1; 11:25; 14:1; 20:1). His ministry extended over twenty-three years (29:17), 595–573 BC, during part of which he was contemporary with Daniel (14:14; 28:3) and Jeremiah, and probably also with Obadiah. The time and manner of his death are unknown.

Then the word of the Lord came to me saying, "Son of man, when the house of Israel was living in their own land, they defiled it by their ways and their deeds; their way before Me was like the uncleanness of a woman in her impurity. Therefore I poured out My wrath on them for the blood which they had shed on the land, because they had defiled it with their idols. Also I scattered them among the nations and they were dispersed throughout the lands. According to their ways and their deeds I judged them. When they came to the nations where they went, they profaned My holy name, because it was said of them, 'These are the people of the Lord; yet they have come out of His land." Ezekiel 36:16-20

"But I had concern for My holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the nations where they went. Therefore say to the house of Israel, 'Thus says the Lord God, "It is not for your sake, O house of Israel, that I am about to act, but for My holy name, which you have profaned among the nations where you went. I will vindicate the holiness of My great name which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst. Then the nations will know that I am the Lord," declares the Lord God, "when I prove Myself holy among you in their sight." Ezekiel 36:21-23

"For I will take you from the nations, gather you from all the lands and bring you into your own land. Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances." Ezekiel 36:24-27

"You will live in the land that I gave to your forefathers; so you will be My people, and I will be your God. Moreover, I will save you from all your uncleanness; and I will call for the grain and multiply it, and I will not bring a famine on you. I will multiply the fruit of the tree and the produce of the field, so that you will not receive again the disgrace of famine among the nations. Then you will remember your evil ways and your deeds that were not good, and you will loathe yourselves in your own sight for your iniquities and your abominations. I am not doing this for your sake," declares the Lord God, "let it be known to you. Be ashamed and confounded for your ways, O house of Israel!" Ezekiel 36:28-32

"'Thus says the Lord God, "On the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will cause the cities to be inhabited, and the waste places will be rebuilt. The desolate land will be cultivated instead of being a desolation in the sight of everyone who passes by. They will say, 'This desolate land has become like the garden of Eden; and the waste, desolate and ruined cities are fortified and inhabited.' " Ezekiel 36:33-35

"Then the nations that are left round about you will know that I, the Lord, have rebuilt the ruined places and planted that which was desolate; I, the Lord, have spoken and will do it." 'Thus says the Lord God, "This also I will let the house of Israel ask Me to do for them: I will increase their men like a flock. Like the flock for sacrifices, like the flock at Jerusalem during her appointed feasts, so will the waste cities be filled with flocks of men. Then they will know that I am the Lord." ' " Ezekiel 36:36-38

Ezekiel chapter 37

The hand of the LORD was on me, and He brought me out by His Spirit [ruach רוּה] and set me down in the middle of the valley; it was <u>full</u> of bones. He led me all around them. There were a <u>great many</u> of them on the surface of the valley, and they were very dry [dead for a long time]. Ezekiel 37:1-2

*This was no recent disaster but the product of a long process of decay and death. And the valley was full of these bones—there were very many. It was a total disaster not merely touching one or two people, but the whole nation. – Peter Jeffery *Has your life ever felt empty, like dry bones?

Then He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" I replied, "Lord God, only You know." Ezekiel 37:3

Prophet Ezekiel knows that only God can accomplish such a feat.

Do we believe that God can give life? Do we believe that He can revive the dead?

Again He said to me, "Prophesy over these bones and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the Lord.' Thus says the Lord God to these bones, 'Behold, I will cause breath [ruach רות] to enter you that you may come to life." Ezekiel 37:4-5

Then the Lord God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being. Genesis 2:7

"I will put tendons on you, make flesh grow on you, and cover you with skin. I will put breath [ruach רוּה] in you so that you come to life. Then you will know that I am The Lord [Yahweh יהוה]." <u>So I prophesied as I had been</u> commanded. While I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. As I looked, tendons appeared on them, flesh grew, and skin covered them, but there was no breath [ruach רוּה] in them. Ezekiel 37:6-8

For a lot of us, we look good on the outside but there is no breath (spiritual life) in us He said to me, "Prophesy to the breath [ruach רות], prophesy, son of man. Say to it: This is what the Lord GOD says: Breath [ruach רוה], come from the four winds [ruach רוה] and breathe into these slain so that they may live!" So I prophesied as He commanded me; the breath [ruach רות] entered them, and they came to life and stood on their feet, a vast army. Ezekiel 37:9-10

*What would happen if the vast army that professes to follow Jesus would come to life and stand on their feet?

Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. Look how they say, 'Our bones are dried up, and our hope has perished; we are cut off." Ezekiel 37:11

The surviving Israelites felt their national hopes had been dashed. Israel had "died" in the flames of Babylon's attack, and had no hope of resurrection. – Bible Knowledge Commentary

Have you ever felt like this? Ezekiel 37:11

"our bones are dried up" – living a life without God
"our hope has perished" – change is impossible
"we are cut off" – God has abandoned us

Therefore, prophesy and say to them: This is what the Lord GOD says: I am going to open your graves and bring you up from them, My people, and lead you into the land of Israel. You will know that I am The Lord, My people, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. I will put My Spirit [ruach רוּם] in you, and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land. Then you will know that I am The Lord. I have spoken, and I will do it." This is the declaration of the LORD. Ezekiel 37:12-14

God promises Physical restoration AND Spiritual restoration

A key to understanding the vision is Ezekiel's use of the Hebrew word ruach רוק. This word is translated as "Spirit" in verses 1 and 14; as "breath" in verses 5, 6, 8, 9, and 10; and as "winds" in verse 9. But in Hebrew <u>the same word</u> is used every single time.

What is the connection between the resurrection of Jesus and the valley of dry bones? The same God was at work in both places. He performed the same kind of miracle. In both places He took someone dead and made Him alive again. In both places He took someone given over to death and raised Him to life.

God the Father brought Jesus to life and He wants to do the same for you.

"As for Me, this is My covenant with them," says the Lord: "<u>My Spirit</u> [ruach רוּה] which is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your offspring, nor from the mouth of your offspring's offspring," says the Lord, "from now and forever." Isaiah 59:21

Isaiah's prophecy reminds us never to abandon God's Word and to allow ourselves to be moved by it.

History Lesson

After King Solomon died the nation of Israel split asunder, in 931 BC. The Southern Kingdom was known as Judah because Judah was its larger tribe and because the country was ruled by a king from that tribe (cf. 1 Kings 12:22–24). The Northern Kingdom was called **Israel**, or sometimes Ephraim (e.g., Hosea 5:3, 5, 11–14) either because Ephraim was the strongest and most influential tribe or because the first king of Israel, Jeroboam I, was an Ephraimite (1 Kings 11:26). Israel was taken into captivity by Assyria in 722 BC, and Judah was taken into exile by Babylon in 605, 597 and 586 BC.

The word of the Lord came again to me saying, "And you, son of man, take for yourself one stick and write on it, 'For Judah and for the sons of Israel, his companions'; then take another stick and write on it, 'For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim and all the house of Israel, his companions.' Then join them for yourself one to another into one stick, that they may become one in your hand. When the sons of your people speak to you saying, 'Will you not declare to us what you mean by these?' say to them, 'Thus says the Lord God, "Behold, I will take the stick of Joseph, which is in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel, his companions; and I will put them with it, with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and they will be one in My hand." ' Ezekiel 37:15-19

"The sticks on which you write will be in your hand before their eyes. Say to them, 'Thus says the Lord God, "Behold, I will take the sons of Israel from among the nations where they have gone, and I will gather them from every side and bring them into their own land; and I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel; and one king will be king for all of them; and they will no longer be two nations and no longer be divided into two kingdoms." Ezekiel 37:20-22




