



COVID-19 blues vs. depression: How to tell the difference

Now that we're several months into the <u>COVID-19 pandemic</u>, many of us are feeling the emotional toll of the uncertainty, worry and dramatic changes to our habits and our lives.

"While it's normal to have frequent thoughts of COVID-19, be mindful if these thoughts become more frequent, or start to impact your daily life," says Catherine Powers-James, Ph.D., a clinical psychologist in our Integrative Medicine Center.

Recognizing symptoms of COVID-19 blues

Everyone's symptoms will be different, Powers-James says, but there are a few common ones to watch for.

If you're generally not feeling like yourself, that may be one of the first signs you're experiencing the blues. "You may find you don't enjoy things as much as you used to," Powers-James says.

Other common symptoms include:

- feelings of sadness, tearfulness, emptiness or hopelessness
- feelings of restlessness
- guilt
- · anger or irritability more than normal
- withdrawing from things you used to enjoy
- avoiding talking to friends and family
- changes in sleep (sleeping too much or not enough)
- thoughts about harming yourself
- changes in appetite or weight (more or less)



Now we who are strong ought to bear [carry] the weaknesses of those without strength and not just please ourselves. Romans 15:1

- *There is an <u>inverse</u> relationship between focusing on the needs of others and spiritual hope
- *As my focus on MY struggles goes UP, my hope decreases
- *As my focus on MY struggles goes DOWN, my hope increases

Each of us is to please his neighbor <u>for his good</u>, to his edification. For even Christ did not please Himself; but as it is written [Psalm 69:9], "The reproaches of those who reproached You fell on Me." Romans 15:2-3

- *Can we be helpful people, not arrogant people?
- *Can we help someone and not publicize it?

Make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose. Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others. Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus... Philippians 2:2-5


*How can our family members and friends KNOW the hope of God's calling, not just OBSERVE it in our lives?

Therefore, prepare your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope [ἐλπίς elpis] completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. As <u>obedient</u> children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, but alike the Holy One who called you, <u>be holy yourselves also in all your behavior</u>; because it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy." 1 Peter 1:13-16

- *There is a direct relationship between spiritual hope and obedience to God
- *As my obedience (personal holiness) goes UP, my hope increases
- *As my obedience (personal holiness) goes DOWN, my hope decreases

Jesus said, "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments." John 14:15

Jesus said, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him." John 14:23

*Fellowship with God and spiritual hope are the rewards for those who obey Jesus.



Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect. Romans 12:1-2

Now may the God who gives **perseverance** and encouragement grant you to be of the same mind with one another according to Christ Jesus, so that with one accord you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 15:5-6

- *What does God-honoring unity look like?
- *How does this type of unity glorify God?
- *Hopeful perseverance requires teamwork



Behold, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear Him, on those who hope יַתַל] yachal] for His lovingkindness, to deliver their soul from death and to keep them alive in famine. Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and our shield. For our heart rejoices in Him, because we trust in His holy name. Therefore, accept [present imperative... keep on accepting] one another, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God. For I say that Christ has become a servant to the circumcision [Jews] on behalf of the truth of God to confirm the promises given to the fathers, and for the Gentiles [non-Jews] to glorify God for His mercy; as it is written [2 Samuel 22:50], "Therefore I will give praise to You among the Gentiles, and I will sing to Your name." Romans 15:7-9

Exclude none

Again he says, "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people [Deuteronomy 32:43]." And again, "Praise the Lord all you Gentiles, and let all the peoples praise Him [Psalm 117:1]." Again Isaiah says, "There shall come the root of Jesse, and He who arises to rule over the Gentiles, in Him shall the Gentiles hope [Isaiah 11:10]." Romans 15:10-12 *WORDS OF*
